TUTORIAL

At Varndean College you will have a Tutorial once a week. This is a compulsory part of your studies and is designed to help you develop as a person and a student. The curriculum is focused on five parts (study, society, self, success and safety) and has been created to help you make the most of your time at College and ensure you are equipped for life after College.





Study badges indicate sessions, resources or external speakers that focus on study skills to help you manage the demands of your courses and develop as a student.



Society badges indicate sessions, resources or external speakers that have been designed to help you prepare for life in modern Britain. Topics like British Values / Varndean Values will be included in these sessions.



Self badges indicate sessions, resources or external speakers that help to develop you personally. This may include topics around wellbeing, support, relationships etc.



Success badges indicate sessions, resources or external speakers that focus on your progress and achievement. This may include helping you prepare for University, further education, apprenticeship and employment.



Safety badges indicate sessions, resources or external speakers that focus on your personal safety. This may include sessions on crime, substance misuse, online safety etc.






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Study badges indicate sessions, resources or external speakers that focus on study skills to help you manage the demands of your courses and develop as a student.

STUDY SKILLS IN TUTORIAL:

As you undertake the challenge of new subjects your study skills will be stretched to meet the inevitable demands of higher level of courses. In your regular 1:1 sessions with your Tutor, your progress will be discussed and they can assist you with further support and/ or signpost you to services within the College.







SOCIETY IN TUTORIAL:
