## Financial Support and Payment Options

### Concessionary Fees

If you are studying an accredited course at Entry Level, Level 1 or Level 2 you may be eligible for a concessionary fee. If you fall into one of the following categories you will need to complete a self-declaration funding form and provide evidence of your means tested benefit. All evidence must be dated within three months of the course start date.

- Claiming Job Seekers Allowance/Employment Support Allowance or Universal Credit.
- Receiving Universal Credit (UC) and your take home pay as recorded on your UC statement (disregarding UC payments and other benefits) is less than £617 per month (learner is sole adult in the benefit claim) or £988 per month (learner has a joint benefit claim with their partner).
- Earning less than £25,000 annual gross salary. You must provide evidence of your salary.

## Retrain as a Counsellor

Study an accredited CPCAB counselling course part-time within our specialist Adult Education Counselling Department. We offer an accessible and professional route to become a counsellor. Most of our counselling tutors are practicing counsellors who share their expertise and learning experiences to enrich a structured and sequenced curriculum.

To start the counselling journey an introduction of 10 weeks gives you the basic skills in talking and listening. Students who have no experience in 1-1 support work in their professional roles need to take this course to progress on to Level 2 Certificate.

Counselling training is not suitable if you are currently experiencing a state of severe emotional difficulty and/or severe psychological distress. Courses involve experiential elements that will involve some personal disclosure and personal developmental activities.

Please note it is imperative you are able to start on the first session of the course as the group will be establishing working relationships from the outset. 80% attendance is compulsory

The Level 2 Certificate is a 30-week course where you will be introduced to the skills of counselling. You will be familiarised with triad work and learn how to reflect on your practice.

Our Level 3 course increased from 90 to 150 hours in academic year 2024/25 to meet the new CPCAB framework. The additional 60 hours is spent on employability to support career pathways. Students must have completed a Level 2 Counselling skills course and face to face skills (90 hours guided learning) to be eligible to do this course.

You may be eligible for an Advanced Learner Loan on Level 3 and 4 courses.

The Level 4 Diploma in Therapeutic Counselling two-year part-time qualification gives learners the knowledge, skills and competencies to work as a therapeutic counsellor in an agency context in both health care and non-medical settings.

Successful completion of this course means you will be able to provide a therapeutic counselling service, initially within the contact of an agency's service framework but later (with experience and supervision support) may progress to independent practice.

Students are required to do 40 hours of personal therapy (mandatory) and complete a 100 hours of professional practice as a student counsellor in an organisation. Please be aware that if the organisation does not provide clinical supervision, then students are required to find this.

Exam fees are included in all of our pricing.
