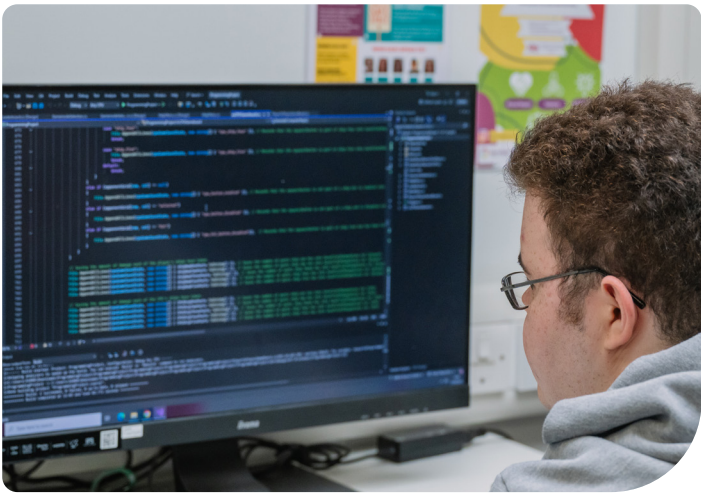

OUR ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

COURSE LEVEL

GENERAL GCSE GRADE MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Advanced Level (Level 3) Programme

IB Diploma or 4 A Levels

A mixture of at least **7 GCSEs** at Grades 6-9 including English, Maths and Science

3 A Levels

A mixture of at least **6 GCSEs** at Grades 4-9 including English

A mixed programme at Level 3 to include at least one vocational course

A mixture of at least **5 GCSEs** at Grades 4-9 including English

Foundation Level (Level 2) programme

At least **4 GCSEs** at Grade 3 including English. At least one GCSE should be Grade 4 or above

Any student who has not achieved a Grade 4 in GCSE Maths must include further study of this subject in their programme.
